

Applying to TUTOR-PHC

SPOR Primary and Integrated Health Care Innovations (PIHCI) Network trainees are encouraged to apply to TUTOR-PHC. BRIC NS is the Nova Scotia PIHCI Network and applicants who are members of BRIC NS will be given preference in the application rankings.

BRIC NS has funds available to cover the \$3000 tuition fee for one (1) BRIC NS member accepted into the program. Preference for BRIC NS support will be given to applicants whose research is related to [BRIC NS priorities](#) and includes patient engagement.

In completing the required sections of the application form consider how you might include the following points (1-6) into the requested sections, as well as in the additional material required to be considered a PIHCIN/BRIC NS applicant.

1. Stress the relevance of your research to primary health care
2. Explain how your career goals include continuing to conduct, or be involved in, primary health care research
3. Explain how participating in TUTOR-PHC will support your career and/or research goals
4. Discuss existing links to primary health care through either research, clinical or organizational affiliations
5. Discuss your experience with interdisciplinary teams through either research, clinical or organizational affiliations
6. Describe the support you will receive from your supervisor, mentor or other colleagues as you complete the program and the experience those people have in primary health care, interdisciplinary teams or other areas related to the goals of TUTOR-PHC.

Please note that people applying as members of BRIC NS are asked to fill out section V of the application form:

“If you are affiliated with a CBPHC Team or a SPOR PIHCI Network, please describe your role in your Team/Network. Please include the name of your CBPHC Team/PIHCI Network, its Principal Investigator(s), and the members with whom you work. (maximum ½ page)”

BRIC NS is happy to work with you in this half page section of the application form and answer questions from your supervisor about this section of the reference form.
